WHAT IS BIG BROTHERS BIG SISTERS?

Big Brothers Big Sisters is not your typical organization.

Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central Texas exists to help children succeed in life. We do this by matching children ages 6 and above with caring adults who serve as mentors, advocates, resources, and guides. Volunteers commit to meeting with their Littles 3 to 4 times per month for a minimum of one year. Our professional staff are there every step of the way to solve problems and support each match's success.

BBBS serves approximately 1,000 children in Travis, Williamson, and Hays counties each year. Our proven model of one-to-one mentoring helps kids build the skills and capacities that lead to lifelong success.

While we serve approximately 1,000 children each year, as many as 200 children are waiting for our services at any given time. We must raise the funds to provide these children with the life-changing mentoring relationships they so richly deserve. We hope that you will join us in meeting this challenge and providing new opportunities for these children.

In 2021:

- 147 new mentoring matches were created, and 780 matches were supported
- 620 kids were matched with their mentor for more than one year
- 46,800 volunteer hours were given by "Bigs"
- \$113,750 in new college scholarships was promised to "Littles"
- 37.5 months was the average match length

Bowl for Kids is one of Big Brothers Big Sisters' signature fundraisers. Each year half a million people across America come together to have fun and raise money to support Big Brothers Big Sisters as we change how children grow up! Bowl for Kids is the perfect way for individuals to make an impact on our community – it only takes a little bit of effort to raise the money that is vital to our program's success.

100% of funds raised through Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central Texas' Bowl for Kids stay local and are used to provide life-changing mentoring services for children in our community.

THE BASICS

1 FORM YOUR TEAM!

2 FUNDRAISE FOR BBBS!

By simply sending an email, texting, posting on social media or asking a few friends for support, you can make a BIG difference. Work with your team and check out our fundraising tips!

3 MOTIVATE YOUR TEAM

Encourage them to raise money for Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central Texas!

Share information about the impact Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central Texas makes on our community.

Keep your team informed about incentive prizes, rules, games, contests, etc.

Communicate their success (Katie just got a \$50 donation! Joel has already exceeded his goal of \$200! Our team just surpassed the \$1,000 mark!)

4 QUALIFY TO BOWL

Raising \$750 qualifies your team for a bowling slot at Highland Lanes!

5 KEEP UP THE AWESOME FUNDRAISING AND CELEBRATE

When your team raises \$1,250 you support one match for an entire year and receive VIB (Very Important Bowler) perks! You can also engage in some exciting team fundraising activities at Treaty Oak Distilling, Bouldin Acres, and Lustre Pearl South through March and April as we prepare for the big celebration at Highland Lanes!

Join us at Highland Lanes on April 22 and 23, 2022, to celebrate your team's success! Remember, it's not about how good a bowler you are, it's celebrating the impact the funds your team has collected will have on our community!



5 SAY THANK YOU!

Thank your team members for their time and commitment to participate! Don't forget to say thank you to the people who donated to you! Call or email them after the event to let them know how much money your team raised and thank them for supporting local children!



BOWL FOR KIDS - FUNDRAISING TIPS

Need help fundraising? Don't worry — we've collected some of the best practices and tips from our top fundraisers below!

Remember, the team fundraising goal is \$750. If you reach \$1,250 as a team you will achieve VIB status and qualify for more prizes and perks!



Have you participated in Bowl for Kids before? Ask former donors and teammates to get involved! If someone donated to your team before, it's very likely that they'll donate again if you ask. If you want to see a list of your old teammates or donors from a past Bowl for Kids event, just let us know! Send an email to Audrie at ajahnsen@bigmentoring.org to request your lists.

Remember the cause! Big Brothers Big Sisters matches at-risk children with caring, adult mentors. Kids who have Bigs are more likely to graduate from high school and college, less likely to use drugs and alcohol, and have higher self-esteem than their peers. Tell potential donors about the cause behind the event and they will be more willing to donate.

Personalize your web page. Personalizing your fundraising web page is easy and fun. Participants who use their web page to raise funds typically raise more money because it's easy to donate with a credit card online. Get started by logging in at www.BowlForKidsAustin.org.

Use social media, texts, and email! Create a regular schedule of communication that includes posts on all your social media channels (*both on the feed and on your stories*), texting, and emailing. Each of your donors will have a different communication style so set a schedule and then repeat and remind.

Ask about company matches. Many companies will match an employee's contributions to a charity. Search for your company at doublethedonation.com or ask your HR department to see if your company has a company match program, and if so, how you can participate. If they do, you could reach your goal even faster! You can enter matching gift amounts on your web page to keep track of your total in real time.

Aim for donations of \$25 or higher. The quickest and easiest way to meet the \$125 goal is to ask 5 people to donate \$25. If you make a personal donation of \$25 first, it will show that you are not asking anyone to give to something you aren't giving to as well.

Tell your personal story. Use your personal fundraising page to answer the question, "Why do you support Big Brothers Big Sisters?" Tell potential donors about any amazing outcomes and personal experiences you may have had with BBBS or your own mentor. People are more likely to remember and donate to a cause when there's a story to go along with it!




Kick-Off Party March 6, 2022



It's our vision that all youth achieve their full potential. To that end, BBBS' mission is to create and support one-toone mentoring relationships that ignite the power and promise of youth. BBBS depends on donations to recruit, screen, and train volunteers, and to provide on-going support for children, families, and volunteers as they build and sustain long-lasting relationships. Last year, more than 97 percent of the children served by BBBS remained in school and avoided early parenting.
